### CHAIR PROF. GIORGIO BERTORELLE

GIORGIO BERTORELLE IS AN ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR IN GENETICS AND A POPULATION GENETICIST. AMONGST HIS INTERESTS, THERE IS THE EVOLUTION AND CONSERVATION OF SEVERAL SPECIES, PATTERNS OF GENOMIC VARIATION, AND BIODIVERSITY LOSS PREVENTION TO FOSTER ENVIRONMENTALLY SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT.

### PROF. MASSIMO BERNARDI

#### MUSEUM AS AN ANTHROPOCENTRIC SITE

MASSIMO BERNARDI IS HEAD OF RESEARCH AND COLLECTIONS DEPARTMENT AT THE MUSEO DELLE SCIENZE (MUSE, TRENTO) WITH A FOCUS ON MASS EXTINCTION IN THE PAST, PRESERVATION, AND ENHANCEMENT OF PALEONTOLOGICAL HERITAGE AND CULTURAL HERITAGE, AND THE CONCEPT OF ANTHROPOCENE. HE IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON NARRATIVES, PERCEPTIONS, AND FACTUAL DATA REGARDING THE GREAT ECOSYSTEM CRISES SUCH AS EXTINCTIONS IN THE GEOLOGICAL PAST AND IN THE PRESENT, EXPLORING SYNERGIES BETWEEN CONSERVATION PALEOBIOLOGY, THE PHILOSOPHY OF THE ANTHROPOCENE, AND SCIENCE COMMUNICATION.
