Principles of Psychopharmacology

The proposed course will address the major psychiatric diseases anxiety, depression, psychosis and schizophrenia, and drug abuse. For each disorder the neurobiological bases, the available therapeutics and their mechanisms of action will be presented. Additionally the course will be focused on the available pre-clinical models of psychiatric diseases and their validity criteria (face, predictive, and construct validity). Finally, for each diseases new therapeutic targets and the future therapeutic perspectives will be presented. There will be 4 lessons of 2 hours.
