CURRICULUM VITAE DANIELE MASETTI

Daniele Masetti was born in Ferrara on the 22th November 1946; he has been associate professor at the Department of Geological and Paleontological Sciences of the University of Ferrara until November 31st, 2000; on November 1st, 2000 he was appointed full professor at the Department of Geological, Envinronmental and Marine Sciences of the University of Trieste; in November 1st, 2008 he moved back to the University of Ferrara. From 1991 to 1996 DM co-ordinated the Ferrara unit involved in the MURST 40% research project -Cyclic Sedimentation in Carbonate Systems-From 1992 to 2000 he led the research unit of the CNR Group Alpi; (a Research Group for geological problems of the Alpine region-Po Valley). In 1996-1997 he directed the Italian group of sedimentologists working at the Cape Roberts Drilling Project (Antartide). The main research field of Daniele Masetti concerns stratigraphy and facies analysis of sedimentary successions, especially carbonate; in this field he was engaged in the study of the stratigraphy of Jurassic successions of the eastern sector of the Southern Alps and in the cyclostratigraphy of pelagic and shallow-water carbonate successions with special emphasis towards Jurassic and Cretaceous black shales of the Southern Alps. The main part of Daniele Masetti latest research activity, made in collaboration with Eni, involved sedimentary rocks relevant as source or, more recently, as reservoir of hydrocarbons. During 2002-2003 coordinated the Trieste unit working at the Prin "Geoevents in the mesozoic history of the Western Tethys: interpretation and valorization". During the two-year period 2005-2007 DM coordinated the same unit inside the Prin: Timing and mode of the biotic crisis between Late Triassic and Early Jurassic. From 2009 to 2012 Daniele Masetti manages as national scientific coordinator the following Prin Project: Demise of the carbonate platforms in the Sinemurian - Pliesbachian time: a new global event? The first of November 2014 Daniele Masetti retired from work.
